Your application Process

How to Apply

Step 1: **Submit an Application**

You can submit and track the status of your application on our Student Portal or through one of our contracted educational representatives/agents. It is important that you provide up to date contact information so you can receive updates and more information about your admission.

When preparing your documents please make sure to provide copies of your Academic and English qualifications and a valid passport.

Step 2: **Receive your offer letter**

Wait to receive your offer. There are two types of offer letters:

Conditional

If your offer is conditional, it means we need to receive further documentation or evidence of your qualifications before offering you a place. Please upload your documents on your Study Link portal or share them with your educational representative. Remember to include your Student ID as a reference.

Unconditional

If you receive an unconditional offer, it means that you have met all the entry criteria for your course and that you have secured a place at ICP. Congratulations!

Step 3: **Accept your offer**

Once you have received an unconditional offer letter, all you need to do is pay the tuition fee deposit and complete the Acceptance Forms attached to your offer. Payments should be paid directly to the University of Portsmouth included in your offer pack. You can pay online on our website or by bank transfer.





Step 4: Receive your CAS letter

If you require a student route visa to study in the UK, you need to obtain a Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS) from us before you can submit a visa application. Our Admissions Team will contact you or your educational representative to advise what documents you need to submit. Once we receive them, we will issue your CAS.

Step 5: Submit your Visa application

Once you have received your CAS statement you can submit your student route visa application. Please keep us posted on the outcome of your application.

Step 6: Book your Accommodation

At ICP, we offer a large range of accommodation options to suit every student's needs. Whether you prefer to live in a self-contained flat, a shared house or a luxurious penthouse, you can check out our providers on our website icp.navitas.com/accommodation and make your pick.

Step 7: Registration and Enrolment

Registration takes place face to face. Once you have received your Visa and booked your accommodation in Portsmouth, you would need to book your flights at least one week before your registration takes place. We will send you your registration dates in due course so that you can plan ahead of time.

Step 8: Bring your documents for registration

We need physical copies of your passport, entry clearance vignette, BRP letter and accommodation contract so make sure you have them all with you when you arrive. We look forward to welcoming you in Portsmouth!

Accommodation

LIVING IN PORTSMOUTH IS A MUST IF YOU WANT TO MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR UNIVERSITY LIFE AT ICP.

There's never a shortage of local activities in and outside the college that can broaden your experience. It is important that you live no more than 30 minutes away from ICP. This will make it easier for you to attend your classes and all other events organised by us or the University of Portsmouth. Take a look at the options that we can offer you:

Accommodation can be university managed or private rented through agents or private landlords.

Choosing your area in Portsmouth

Although a small city, Portsmouth comprises a mixture of diverse areas, each with a unique aesthetic. As it's a coastal location, you can find plenty of properties located near the seafront, close to the Southsea Common and the City Centre. Accommodation is available for all budgets so you can do your research to find which area and price point is best for you.

Central Locations

Southsea and Fratton are your best bets if you prefer to live close to the city centre. Only a short walk from ICP with all the facilities almost at your doorstep. The area also encompasses a variety of different shared houses/flats, studios, lodgings that you can rent for yourself or with your fellow students. Depending on the type of accommodation you choose, rent prices can range from £80 to £100/week per person. As these are central locations, rent will be more expensive.

East and North of Portsmouth

If peace and quiet is what you are after, you can shift your focus to areas like Eastney, Milton, North End and Hilsea. Good transport links are available so you can easily commute to the college and the City Centre.

Outside the City

Areas such as Drayton, Farlington, Cosham, Fareham and Gosport are located further away from the City Centre. This means that the rent will be cheaper but you will need to use public transport or a bike when coming to the college. Gosport is situated on a peninsula so you would need to use the ferry when commuting to Portsmouth. The journey is only 5 minutes so it is still a manageable distance.

Types of Accommodation

Shared houses/flats

You and your friends can rent an entire property that you can share amongst yourselves. Rent and bills are shared which means that you will pay less than what you normally would if you were renting a single occupancy house/flat. This is a good option if you are on a tight budget but also when you are looking to meet fellow students.

Self-contained studios

If you like your privacy, you can opt for a studio flat. Studios offer you enough space in which you can have your own kitchenette, bathroom and bedroom, all in one main living area. A studio is more affordable than a flat and slightly more costly than a shared house/flat. In some cases, bills can be included in the rent, however you would need to check with the landlord/agent before booking.

Whatever accommodation you choose, it could either be:

Catered or Non-catered

If you'd rather have ready-made food and skip the hassle of cooking, you can choose catered accommodation. Professional meals are prepared for you daily and you can have a variety of foods served every week.

On the other hand, if you want to master your chef skills or if you are already confident with cooking, you can choose the non-catered option.

Furnished, Semi-Furnished or Unfurnished

- Furnished accommodation means that white goods and furniture such as wardrobe, bed, sofas and desks are included in the property. So you won't have to spend extra money on buying your own.
- Semi-furnished means that some furniture such might be included however, you'd need to buy some extra for the property to be complete.
- Unfurnished accommodation means that no furniture is included and you are only renting the living space. Unfurnished houses/flats are usually cheaper as you'd need to populate them with your own furniture.

Inclusive or exclusive of bills

- Student halls usually come fully furnished and they include all the bills in the rent. University managed security is also available so you can feel safe in your space 24/7. Maintenance is also provided by the university so if the fridge breaks down for example, help will be on the way free of charge.
- Some private accommodation can also offer properties with all or some of the bills included in the rent. You would need to check with the agents or the landlord before signing a contract to ensure what your responsibilities will be as a tenant.



When you rent student accommodation in the UK, you will have your own single occupancy room. This will include your own bed, wardrobe and desk. You can also choose to have your own ensuite bathroom. Any shared spaces and facilities would include the kitchen, laundry and living rooms, as well as study and entertainment places.

Entry Requirements

To qualify for ICP, you have to meet our academic and English Language requirements. No matter where you are from, we can review and accept qualifications from all over the world.
