The University of Reading was established in 1892, with origins as a University of Oxford extension college. It is now one of the UK's leading research universities, enjoying a world-class reputation for teaching, research and enterprise. From the creation of the now globally iconic Climate Stripes to pre-empting worldwide natural disasters, we are a leading university in climate science, working with governments and advising policymakers.

Reading town is a major commercial centre and is home to the Oracle shopping mall, theatres and a whole host of restaurants, cafes and other social venues. The University is just a short distance from the town centre, with buses from our campus to town running 24 hours a day during term time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The University has set entry criteria for all courses, and this may vary depending on which course you apply for. Some courses may require you to have previously studied a certain subject, or subjects, and you may also be required to obtain an English Language Test.

For certain applications the University is able to assess on a case-by-case basis, and so significant relevant work experience can in some cases be taken into account.
