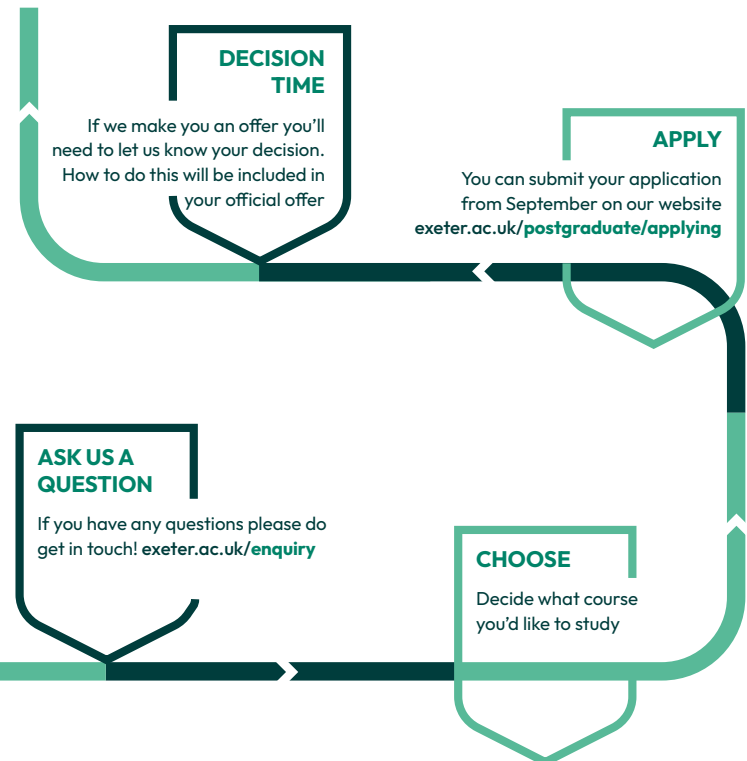

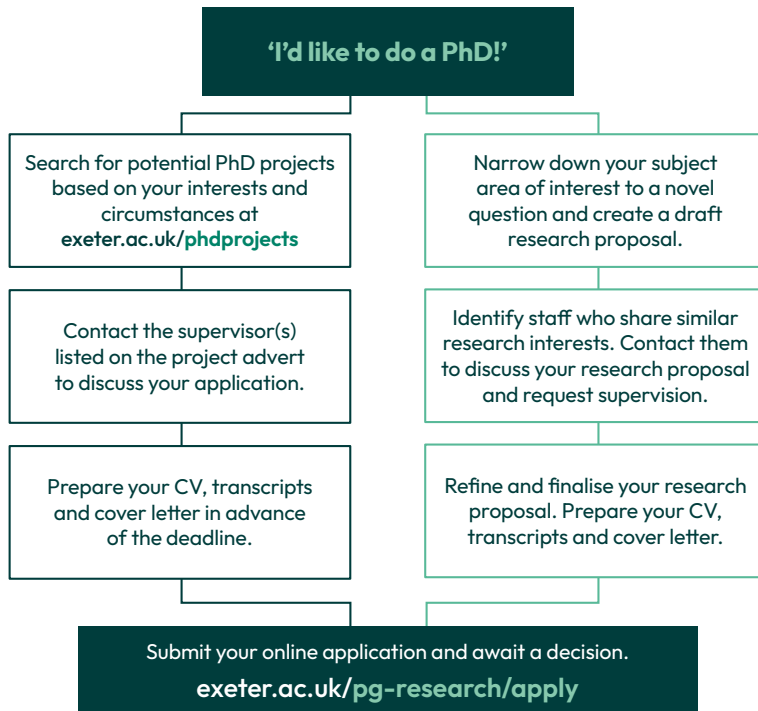

# Finance

**When planning how to fund your postgraduate degree, make sure you start early and think creatively; the sooner you do, the longer you have to research opportunities and get funds together. Alongside your tuition fees you will need to account for living costs and accommodation, as well as other potential course costs.**

## University of Exeter Global Excellence Scholarships

Our Global Excellence Scholarships of £7,500 are available for international fee paying students applying to study a Taught Masters with us in September 2024, and will be awarded for outstanding academic quality.

As scholarships will be awarded from the beginning of the application cycle, we encourage an early application before all funds are allocated.

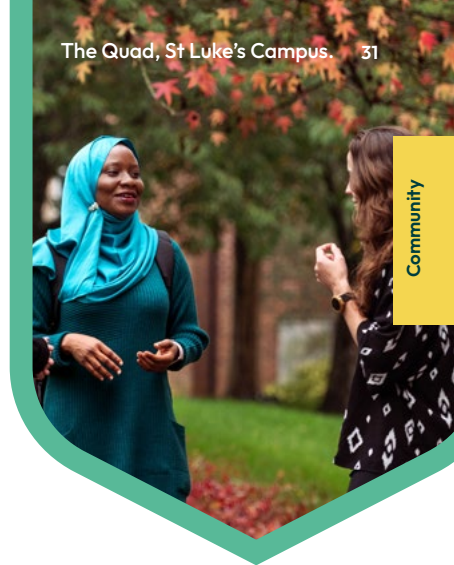
